

REACH REGISTRATION STATUS

Horizons Incorporated, through its Imaging Systems Group, imports into the European Union a line of articles commonly used in the manufacture of labels, nameplates, and placards.

In order to create the image on these articles, some require the intentional release of substances during processing. These articles include:

- Metalphoto® Photosensitive Aluminum
- AlumaMark® Laser Markable Aluminum
- DuraBlack® Laser Markable Aluminum
- ID-Mark® Photosensitive Aluminum
- ID-Mark® Photosensitive Polyester
- PolyColor® plates and sheets

The total amount of substances released in the European Union by these articles is less than 1 ton per year, so no registration of the released substances is required.

No intentional release occurs from the following articles;

- AlumaJet® Ink Jet Printable Aluminum
- EconAlum® anodized-only material
- VinylJet® Waterproof Ink Jet Printable Vinyl

We wish to emphasize that where an intentional release occurs, the release is limited to the processing stages involving image creation on the article. **No intentional release occurs in fully processed sheets or in the finished article.**

Also note that the listed preparations contain less than 0.1% of any substance on the Candidate List under Annex XIV as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) (as of January 15th, 2019).
